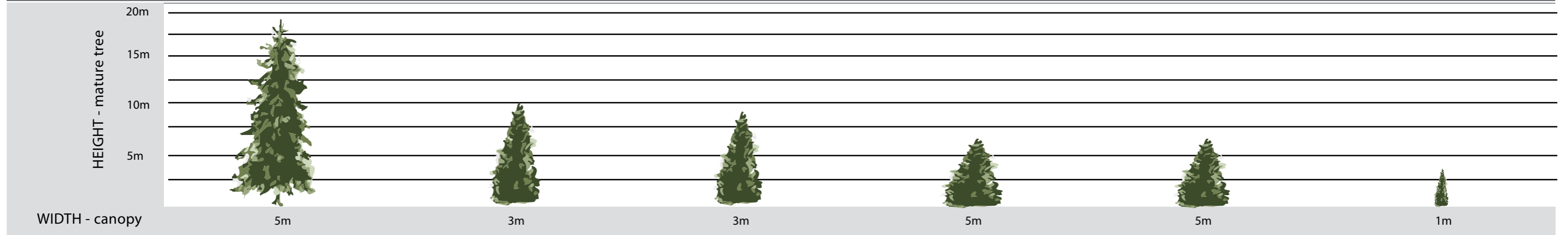

General Info	Also known as 'Wintergreen'. Dense/compact aromatic foliage. Green/yellow cones are slender and up to 18mm in length. Male red/purple pollen cones 3-4mm long shed yellow pollen in spring.	Upright compact and dense foliage that prunes well	Upright compact tree with dense aromatic foliage	Slightly aromatic very dense foliage	Slightly aromatic compact/dense feathery foliage. Conical but very broad at the base. 'Zebrina' is a variegated form of Western Red Cedar.	Slightly aromatic compact/dense foliage. Low maintenance. Urn-shaped cones are slender, yellow-green ripening brown and 10-15mm long.
